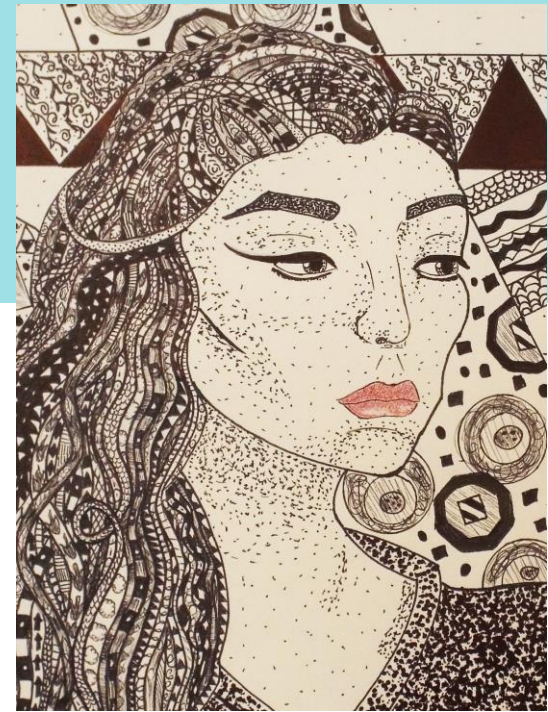

This is a juried student competition of 2-D or 3-D artwork, open to students in grades 7-12 in the Ashtabula Area School District and Buckeye Local School District, including private and homeschooled students. All mediums are welcome. Award winners will receive a scholarship for classes at the Arts Center. Awards will be given on presentation night, Friday, April 21, 6-7 p.m. All entrants will have their work on display in the Ashtabula Arts Center gallery for the month of April.

To Apply: Each student can submit their work either through their teacher or directly to the Arts Center. Any work produced during the 2022-2023 school year is eligible. Students may submit up to 3 pieces.

Labeling: Each piece must be labeled on the front right top corner with the provided tags. The tag will have the student name, address, phone number, grade, school, title, and price if for sale (if not for sale, mark NFS.)

Drop-Off: This entry form must be completely filled out and submitted with students' work.

Presentation: Flat pieces should be matted or backed with mat board, poster board, or heavy-weight paper. Framing is not required, but framed pieces or work on canvas must be wired for hanging.

Artwork dropoff: March 31, 9 a.m.-1 p.m.

Exhibit on display: April 6-30

Reception & awards presentation: Sunday, April 14, 1-2:30 p.m.

Artwork pickup: May 1-2, 9 a.m.- 8 p.m.
