Entry Guidelines:

Entries must be the original work of entering artist. Giclee prints are not allowed. Artwork must have been completed in the last 5 years.

Artwork that has previously been exhibited at the Ashtabula Arts Center is not eligible.

Adults and high school students are invited to enter.

2-D work must be framed and wired, ready to hang.

3-D art must be stable and not exceed 200 lbs.

Accepted artwork must remain on display until the show closes.

Artwork not retrieved within 10 days of the show closing becomes property of Ashtabula Arts Center.

Ashtabula Arts Center retains a 30% commission on all art sales.

Entered artwork does not have to be made available for sale.

Artists allow Ashtabula Arts Center to use their name and images of their artwork for promotional purposes.

Artwork must be signed in and out at the front desk.

Artwork should be tagged on the front right top corner.

Cath Smith, 2026 juror

Cath Smith is a British-born, Ohio-based multidisciplinary artist and educator working in ceramics and oil painting. Her practice is rooted in thoughtful making, strong form, and close attention to material, surface, and proportion. In both her wheel-thrown porcelain vessels and her paintings, she values restraint, clarity, and quiet emotional presence.

Teaching and mentorship are central to Smith's work. She is known for guiding artists with patience and generosity, helping them build technical confidence while developing their own voice through careful observation and intentional decision-making.

Alongside an active studio practice, Smith brings broad experience in critique and review across disciplines. As a juror, she values work that is honest, resolved, and made with clear intention.
